Your involvement

What you'll get out of performing

Still on the fence? Here's what performing can offer you:

- A moment to shine Show your friends and family what you've been working on.
- A team to dance with Experience the joy of creating something together.
- A stage to grow on Learn performance skills like musicality, expression, and stage presence.
- A memory to keep forever You'll be amazed at how good it feels when the lights come up.

Yes, you'll probably make mistakes. Everyone does. But you'll also feel proud, accomplished, and maybe even a little bit braver.

Your role in the production

You'll learn your performance piece in your regular class, with the option to join in for each class you attend.

Extra rehearsals

You've probably got a hectic schedule and can't add in extra rehearsals to your regular classes. That's not a problem, because we aim to minimise the time commitment, with choreography taught and practiced in class.

The only extra rehearsals are those that bring the whole case together:

- Dress Rehearsal: Sunday 19 October, 1–5pm at the Dragonfly Dance Studio
- Theatre Rehearsal + Performance: Saturday 1 November, from 2pm at Brighton Theatre

By registering, you agree to:

- Attend class regularly
- Let us know in advance if you'll be a way for a few weeks
- Catch up if you miss class (via video or help from classmates)
- Be at both the dress rehearsal and the full run at the theatre

If you have a previous commitment on dress rehearsal day, let your teacher know so they can advise what to do.

How to join the lineup

It's simple:

- **Register online:** via the form on www.dragonflydance.com.au/showcase2025-performers
- Or pick up a paper form at the studio (online is preferred and is the best way to make sure there are no glitches with your registration.
- Registrations open: Tuesday 15 July
- Registrations close: Saturday 31 August (no late registrations, sorry!)

After Performer Registrations close, we will be sending a separate Performer Guide with detailed information on hair, makeup, tights, shoes, costume packing tips, rehearsal expectations, and more. This will be available on the Showcase Performer Page of our website.

Who's performing what?

Want what your class is doing? At the end of this info pack you'll find a list of participating classes, the TV theme songs they're dancing to, and a brief outline of the costume vision. This section will be updated regularly on the Performer Information Page, so check back often!

Fees, costumes and what's Included

Performing in the showcase comes with a registration fee that helps cover:

- Theatre hire
- Staff time (this thing takes a LOT of planning and preparation)
- Admin and tech
- Rehearsals
- · Photos and professional video recording

Fees

- \$40 for your first dance
- \$10 for each additional dance
- \$20 to contribute to the cost of photos and videos of the performance
- \$20 costume fee per dance

Examples: if you perform with

- One class, your fee would be \$80 (\$40 registration + \$20 photos/videos + \$20 costume)
- Two classes, you fee would be \$110 (\$40 + \$10 for registration, \$20 for photos and video, 2 x \$20 for two costumes)

Value: priceless

How to pay

Choose from 4 options:

- 1. **Pay in full:** Make a one-time full payment through your Mindbody account at the time of registration
- 2. **Automatic instalments:** Complete a form to setup a scheduled automatic payment plan (available on the Showcase Performer web page) that will ensure your balance is paid by 31 August 2025.
- 3. Pay by EFT when you register (reference showcase-yourname)

If you registered but haven't paid your fees by 31 August, they will be deducted from your Mindbody account (using your primary payment method) on Monday 8 September.

Accessible payment option

Refund policy

There will be no refunds for showcase registration fees unless one of the following applies:

- The class I registered to perform with does not end up participating in the showcase and I am unable to join another class
- The showcase is cancelled
- I am unable to participate due to extenuating circumstances such as serious illness or injury (not including scheduling conflicts or change of mind)

Costumes

Costuming for the showcase is about creating a visually cohesive and exciting performance, while keeping things simple, low-cost, and achievable for adult dancers. We want everyone to look and feel great on stage, without unnecessary stress or expense. We aim to ensure dancers feel confident in their costume, to accommodate different body types and concerns, and to make it affordable. Your teacher will consult with the class about costumes.

We have a large collection of costumes that may be used, and the costume fee covers things like cleaning, sorting, issuing, and returns. In some cases, dancers might wear something of their own and add a costume piece—purchased or borrowed from our collection or another dancer—for an extra splash of pizzazz.

The \$20 fee per dance covers \$20 worth of costuming, whether that's admin time, cleaning and storage, or an item purchased by the teacher (or a class member) and reimbursed.

Sometimes a class may choose to make an accessory or simple item of costume. Some classes even hold a sewing session together.

If a class wants something that costs more than \$20 per person, that will be discussed with the teacher and group. The teacher will then coordinate how the extra cost is managed and who purchases what.

All costume ideas and final choices must be approved by the showcase director, but the teacher is responsible for coordinating the process. Please don't purchase or make anything unless your teacher has confirmed it's approved.
